

## Restaurant openings in NYC: SaltBrick Tavern, Gringo's Tacos, Butcher & Banker and more

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Craving something new? We've got you covered.

Whether you are just in need of a change, looking for your new neighborhood spot, or want to stay ahead of the curve when it comes to the next big restaurant trend, the city is always delivering with new food destinations.

Here's a look at some recent openings that offer a little variety for your dining life.

**SaltBrick Tavern:** This pub-style steakhouse is serving up chef Christopher Kim's eclectic takes on American cuisine, such as a bone-in pork schnitzel with German potato salad (\$25) and a burger prepared with beef aged in rooms lined with slabs of Himalayan sea salt (\$19). (The burger comes smothered in raclette and a roasted garlic aioli and it's served with fries on the side.) For bar snacks to munch on while you sip a locally brewed beer or a specialty cocktail, there's a lobster BLT steam bun (\$5) and tater tots with herbed sour cream. Save room for dessert: Executive pastry chef Tracy Wilk has concocted treats that will remind you of your childhood favorites, like a PB s'mores baked Alaska (\$12).
